Location: **Both events will be held online** (links will be provided to registered participants via email).

Summary: Both training sessions offer the same program. You only need to attend once. Each session is designed to suit different time zones.

The first hour includes an overview of the APEC project approval process and the quality criteria used for assessing projects. Participants will learn how to turn quality ideas into quality Concept Notes.

The second hour will involve an introduction to the APEC Project Administration System (APAS), which all Project Overseers will use to draft, revise and submit Concept Notes and Project Proposals. The session will conduct a brief walkthrough of the website, demonstrating how to navigate through all relevant processes to submit an APEC project application online.

The training will close with a Question and Answer section.

Please note that we cap attendance at the virtual training to a maximum of five (5) participants from the same organization, to ensure as many organisations as possible can access the training. PMU will monitor registrations and communicate with any organisations with more than 5 registered participants.

Who should attend?

- Individuals preparing to apply for APEC project funding for the first time;
- Existing Project Overseers of APEC projects seeking a refresher on the APEC project cycle.
- APEC delegates and prospective Project Overseers looking to familiarise themselves with APAS.

How are the sessions run?

Both events will be held **virtually** via Microsoft Teams. The online meeting links will be provided to registered participants closer to the event dates.

Who will present the sessions?

The sessions are presented by the Project Management Unit (PMU) of the APEC Secretariat and a key member of the APAS Core Team. The presenters will be Ms Estella Ho, Project Coordinator and Teddy Pavon, Program Director.
